Winter is here!



Water:

The cold temperatures have arrived!! If you are planning on being gone for an extended time the city <u>strongly recommends</u> having your water meter turned off to avoid any potential leak disasters.

Be Prepared! Winter Snow Removal Requirements:

Snow plowing season is here and the City is asking for your cooperation. East Hope streets are narrow, please do not park in public right-of-way areas this makes plowing extremely difficult. The City will not be held responsible for damage done to vehicles that are located within its rights-of-way. The City is asking that you do not shovel or plow snow into the City's streets. This causes a safety hazard for other motorist and the City's snow removal equipment.

Building Permit:

The City has both building codes and zoning codes, so if you are starting a project such as a shed, deck, addition or new build please check with the City to see what permits you will need and if it meets zoning setbacks. A simple phone call or email to discuss your project will save you time and frustration as you plan for your project. We are seeing an increase in activity in the area and permits are taking 4 to 6 weeks to process so please plan your projects accordingly.

Vacation Rentals:

The City has regulations concerning Vacation/Short-Term Rentals that were adopted with the new Zoning & Subdivision Ordinance #285. If you operate a Vacation Rental/Short-Term Rental, you are required to register with the City. The registration fee for the first year is \$50.00 and subsequent years are \$25.00. Vacation Rentals/Short-Term Rentals Registration forms are available to download on the City's website.

Public Notary Services:

The city clerk is a Notary Public. The City will be offering this service during business hours. You may contact the City if you have additional questions.

Chicken Cranberry Pinwheels

Ingredients:

4 oz cream cheese, softened

1 tsp Dijon mustard

1/4 cup finely chopped celery

2/3 cup dried cranberries

1/3 cup crumbled feta cheese

4 large flour tortillas

1/3 cup mayonnaise

3 cups cooked chicken

2 green onions, sliced

1/2 cup chopped toasted pecans

salt & pepper

Instructions:

In a large bowl, use a wooden spoon to stir together cream cheese, mayonnaise, and Dijon mustard until smooth. Stir in the chicken, celery, green onion, dried cranberries, pecans, and feta cheese. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Place flour tortillas on a microwave-safe plate. Cover with a damp paper towel and microwave on high for 20 seconds. Spread 1/4 of the cream cheese mixture on each tortilla. Roll them up tightly and wrap in plastic wrap. Refrigerate for at least 1 hour. Slice into 1-inch slices.
